

solarcache Gateway Quick-Start Guide – LAN

1. Turn off your solarcache controller, wait ten seconds, then turn it on again.

2. Connect the Gateway to a spare port on your router using the supplied cable.

3. Plug the power supply tubular connector into the Gateway, and the power supply module itself into a 13A mains socket. Turn on the mains socket.

4. After 2 minutes, touch the “?” button in the top right-hand corner of the solarcache controller’s screen. You should see the Gateway’s local IP address shown below the green line in the middle of the screen as in this example:

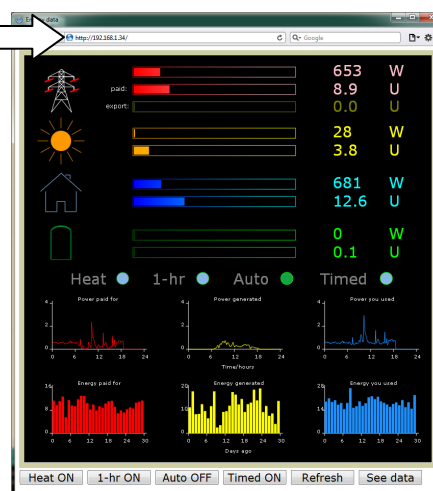

That’s it. You can now run a web browser such as Safari, Internet Explorer, Edge, Chrome, Opera etc. on your pc, tablet computer, iPhone, or smartphone from anywhere inside your house. Simply open the web browser and put in your Gateway’s local IP address on the address line at the top. (The characters “http://:” and “/?” have been added automatically by the browser in this example.)
